1. How did the 2<sup>nd</sup> Anniversary Celebration impact you? What were the highlights for you and why?
2. Spend a few moments in prayer, specifically thanking God for how good He was to us in 2011.
3. The vision of Transformation Church flows from God's heart as communicated through the TWO GREATS: The Great Commandment and The Great Commission.
  - Read Matthew 22:37-40.
    - Can you see Upward, Inward, Outward? Jesus said in verse 40, "On these two commandments depend all the Law and the prophets." This is God's goal for every human on earth. What is the practical implication for our lives individually and as a church corporately?
  - Read Matthew 28:18-20.
    - The word "nations" is important in this passage. In the Greek, "nation" is ethnos. ***Ethnos means ethnic group.*** Jesus didn't suggest to His 1st-century disciples, nor does He suggest to His blood-purchased Church today, but He commands His people to go make disciples of all ethnic groups. And all ethnic groups include all ages and social classes. And Jesus' command isn't just to make disciples of ethnic groups across the sea, BUT also ACROSS THE STREET! Discuss this concept and how it applies to each of us in our daily lives.
    - A disciple (student) is someone who is trained in how to live Upward, Inward, Outward. This is holistic—not just being able to quote Bible verses. Discuss this holistic development as a follower of Christ and where you see Him working most in you right now.
  - Can you how the "multi-ethnic, multi-generational, mission-shaped" part of our vision has followed out of the TWO GREATS? Discuss this so that you can articulate it when asked!

- Read the vision together:
  - We are a multi-ethnic, multi-generational, mission-shaped community that loves God completely (Upward), ourselves correctly (Inward), and our neighbors compassionately (Outward).
  - Are you starting to see life through our Upward, Inward, Outward vision? How has this transformed your life?
- 4. Take some time and pray for TC Rock Hill. Pray that God blesses us to reach many people in Rock Hill with His Upward, Inward, Outward vision that will transform lives!

It's such an honor to serve you and to serve with you as Jesus powerfully displays Himself through His vision for TC.
